Sample itineraries:

Option 1: All about the whales

This itinerary is designed to maximize the amount of in-water time interacting with whales by remaining in the area around Grand Turk, Salt Cay and Big Sand Cay for the entire charter. This is where the majority of the whales can be found.

Guests would fly into Providenciales, then catch a small plane to Grand Turk where they would join the boat. Drop off would also be at Grand Turk.

As long as weather permitted, most of each day would be dedicated to watching whales and looking for opportunities to swim with them.

There would still also be opportunities to scuba dive the reefs around these islands.

Option 2 : Explore the islands

This itinerary involves sailing greater distances each day to explore and dive more of the Turks and Caicos Islands. There will still be opportunities to see and swim with whales on days 2,3 and 4.

There are many incredible beaches, dive sites along the way, with a mixture of developed and uninhabited islands.

Pick up and drop off would be in Providenciales, close to the main airport.

Day 1 - Providenciales

Day 2 - South Caicos

Day 3 - Grand Turk

Day 4 - Salt Cay

Day 5 - Big Sand Cay

Day 6 - French Cay

Day 7 - West Caicos

Day 8 - Return to Providenciales
